Resolution Supporting the Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2012 Statewide Crackdown

WHEREAS, impaired drivers on our nation's roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; **and**,

WHEREAS, 25% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcohol-related; and,

WHEREAS, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and,

WHEREAS, the summer season and the Labor Day holiday in particular are traditionally times of social gatherings which include alcohol; **and**,

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over 2012 Statewide Crackdown*; **and**,

WHEREAS, the project involved increased impaired driving enforcement from August 17th, through September 3rd, 2012; **and**,

WHEREAS, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving saves lives on our roadways;

NOW, THRERFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Council declares it's support for the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* 2012 Statewide Crackdown initiative held from August 17th through September 3rd, 2012 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
